

More About the Lumber Lugger of PunchList HandiWorks:

This product is all about moving very '**frequently used materials**' (the most frequent being long lumber and 4-foot by 8-foot sheet materials such as plywood, siding, etc.) which cannot be moved by the '**typical transporters**' which are readily available (the most typical being hand trucks, wheelbarrows, & wagons).

Lowes & Home Depot have carts for their customers that are not practical for home or job site use. They take up too much space for most homeowners; they are too large & heavy to load into trucks to take to job sites; and they have relatively small, narrow, & hard wheels (which are fine for paved, flat surfaces) but useless on earthen or gravel surfaces.

Lumber Luggers have large, wide, & air cushioned wheels which are great for unpaved, unlevel, & uneven surfaces.

When fully 'collapsed' & ready for storage, the **Lumber Lugger** takes up about 42 by 30 inches of floor space:



When fully 'extended' the **Lumber Lugger** is ready for lugging up to 12-foot-long materials be it lumber, siding, plumbing, or fencing:



Below are pictures of an extended **Lumber Lugger** loaded with materials:





When materials are placed evenly over the wheels & axle, the user doesn't have to strain any muscles, back, or neck to support the balanced load. The long 'handlebars' offer a lot of leverage for their light load.
